At the end of this month, we will be getting back to our small group activities by offering everyone a new

Grab Gather and Grow!) study, called "Creed," to begin the first week of October. The study was written by the Rev. Dr. Adam Hamilton and his team at Church of the Resurrection in Kansas City. (This is one of the biggest and most vital churches in our denomination, and Adam is the leader of the Progressive/Centrist movement that is working out how the overwhelming majority of

United Methodist churches in America can become fully inclusive of all people, as we are at Avondale.)


"Creed" is a study based upon the Apostles' Creed, which is a succinct overview of basic Christian beliefs. It offers a brief video first, explaining a tenet of the Creed and that sets the foundation for an in-depth discussion of your beliefs and how they apply in your everyday life. Adam's small group studies are the best—which many of you know from past experience. This one is particularly thought-provoking.

As always with our **63** small group studies, we will provide a group leader's book with the discussion questions, a copy of the hardback book Creed, and a DVD for you to take and lead a group wherever and with whomever you like—no charge. The requirements are minimal... one hour, once a week, for six weeks—to grow closer to God and to live more joyfully. That's what it costs: 6 hours. The study materials are free to anybody who wants to gather a group- please let us know when and where your group will meet in case other folks want to join you. I will lead a group on Wednesdays at church beginning on October 2. Everyone is welcome.

Think about who you want to journey with through this study and GRAB a study packet on September 22 or 29 at church, GATHER a group of friends, and GROW together in October!

The Handbell Choir Rehearsals will begin on Wednesday September 11th at 6pm!


